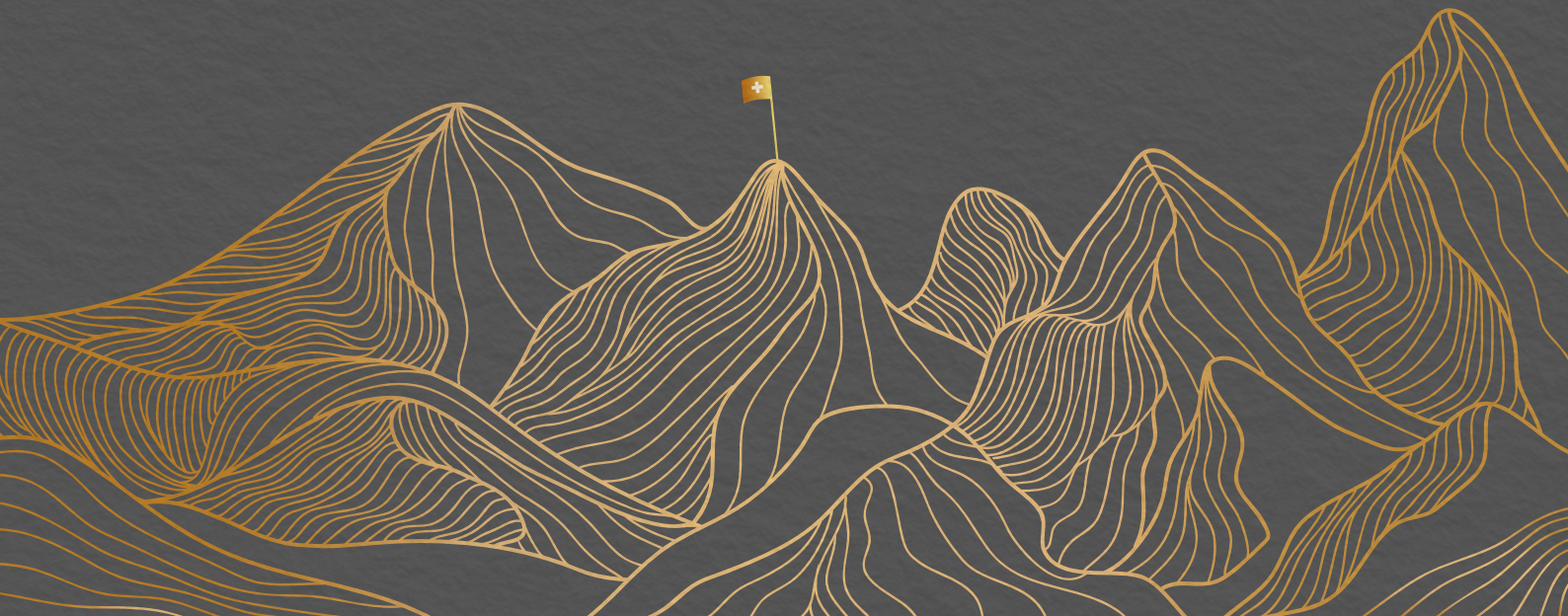
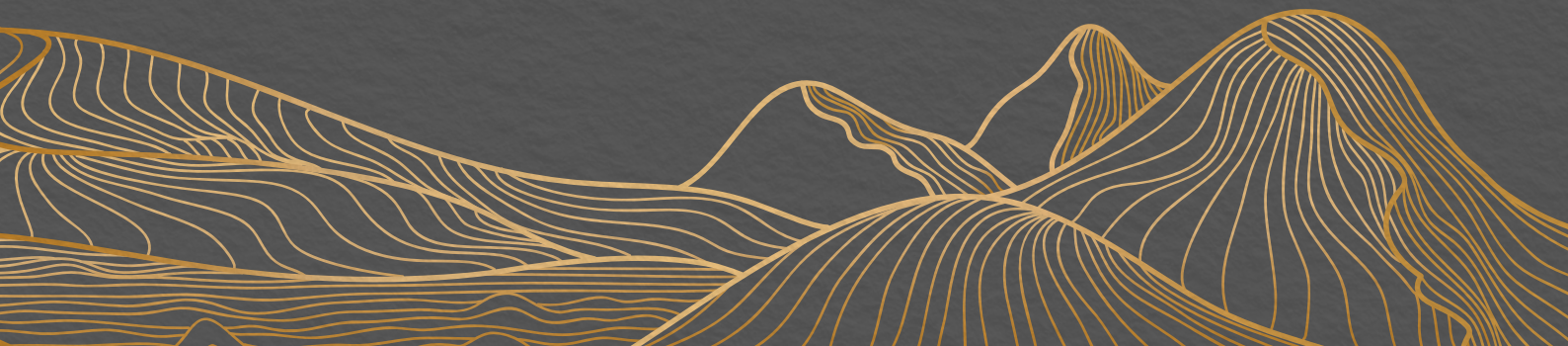

Fendant

Valaisan name given to Chasselas, a typical Swiss grape variety. It is the most cultivated white grape variety in the Valais. Dry and fruity wine, with a mineral character

Johannisberg

Also named Sylvaner, Johannisberg takes its name from a small village in the Rheingau region in Germany. Dry wine naturally low in acidity, with floral notes on a base of orchard fruits.

Petite Arvine

The great Valais white wine of international reputation! Since 1602, Arvine has been considered exclusively as Valaisan. A complex, concentrated, virile and intense wine, with a fine iodised touch.

Païen

Valaisan name given to Savagnin Blanc, also known as Heida in the upper Valais.

Robust grape variety, these wines are amongst the highest in Europe in the Visperterminen region (1100m) - Slightly aromatic, with wild rustic notes.

Chardonnay

Introduced in the Valais region in 1921, it is the most cultivated white grape variety in the world. Fresh wine, with white fruits and floral notes.

Sauvignon blanc

Child of the Savagnin Blanc ; It is naturally crossed with Cabernet Franc to have the Cabernet Sauvignon. Wines high in acidity, distinguished by aromas of red currants and blackcurrant buds

Amigne

Valaisan grape variety, typical of Vétroz.

The Amigne de Vétroz is classified by bees: 1 bee representing the driest and 3 the syrupiest. Rich and powerful wines

Gamay

Descendant of the Pinot Noir, it was introduced into the Valais during the major restructure of the vineyard in the 19th century. Vinified on its own, it is a sapid, joyful and light wine, with supple tannins and a sustained acidity.

Dôle

A dashing grape variety, born from Pinot Noir and Gamay. It is a must in Valais, expressing itself according to the soil.

Pinot

The most common red grape variety in Valais, it appeared in Valais in 1848, and was known as dôle until 1942. Wines with red fruit notes (strawberries, raspberries), full of finesse and elegance.

Merlot

A moderately late variety, Merlot is cultivated throughout the world. Coming from the Cabernet family, it was introduced in Ticino in 1907. Notes of roasted coffee, espresso and burnt cherry

Syrah

Syrah is characteristic of the Rhône region. According to the most famous critics, it competes with the greatest international vintages... Full-bodied and structured wines, distinguished tannins and purple colour.

Humagne

Born from a cross between Cornalin and an unknown Valdotain grape variety, Humagne arrived in Valais via the Pass of Grand Saint-Bernard. It is a characteristic wine from the Valais. A light wine, always dry with notes of oak bark.

Cornalin

A late ripening grape variety, temperamental, difficult to work with, resulting from the crossing of two Valle d'Aosta grape varieties in the 14th century. It was almost abandoned in the XX c. Wines of character, intense, long and mellow fruit, with elegance on the palate and a very present tannic structure.

Cabernet

Although it is one of the main grape varieties of the great Bordeaux wines, Cabernet Franc takes its ancestral origins from the Spanish Basque Country. It makes wines with violet aromas, marked by tannins with varying degrees of herbaceous notes, depending on the yields.

Real compositions of winegrowers, these wines of authors play on the complementarity of the grape varieties.

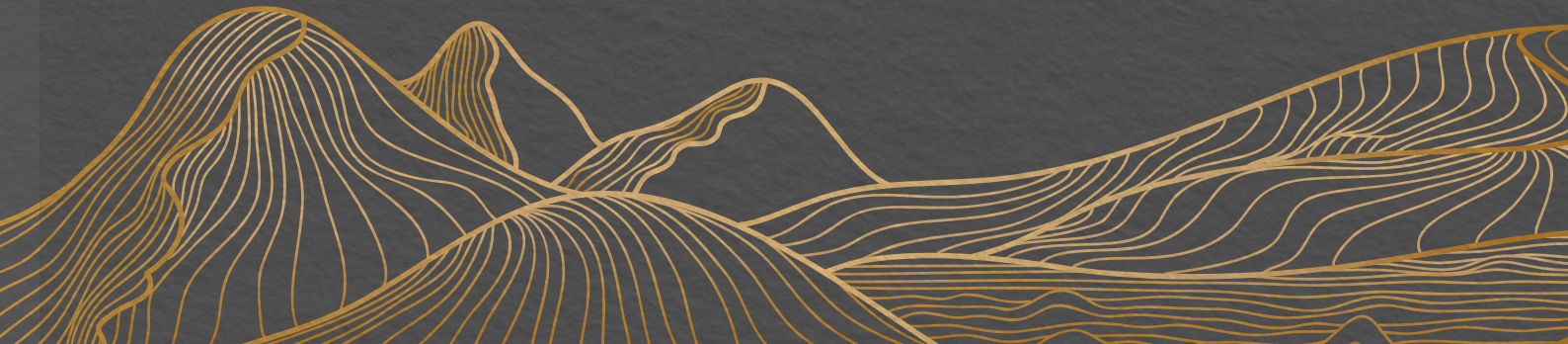
Tessin
